Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Kostas Gourdeas

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC), Dr Lynne Coulson Barr OAM, has issued an interim prohibition order against Mr Kostas Gourdeas, who provided massage therapy services in Unley.

Mr Gourdeas is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935 (CLCA).

Previous consecutive prohibition orders against Mr Gourdeas were effective for 12 weeks; from 17 June to 8 September 2025, 3 October to 26 December 2025, and 27 December 2025 to 11 June 2026, respectively.

This notice advises that a further interim prohibition order relating to the same matter will be effective for a period of 12 weeks, commencing 12.01am, 12 June 2026.

During this time Mr Gourdeas is banned from providing, offering, advertising or otherwise promoting massage therapy services.

Dr Coulson Barr explained that she is in contact with South Australian Police on this matter, and that an investigation from the Office of the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner is ongoing.

As this matter is an active investigation the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
