## **Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Kostas Gourdeas**

The Interim Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC), Ms Debbie Martin, has issued an interim prohibition order against Mr Kostas Gourdeas, who provides massage therapy services in Unley.

Mr Gourdeas is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935* (CLCA).

Previous consecutive prohibition orders against Mr Gourdeas were effective for 12 weeks; from 17 June 2025 to 8 September 2025, and 3 October 2025 to 26 December 2025, respectively.

This notice advises that a further interim prohibition order relating to the same matter will be effective for a period of 12 weeks, commencing 12.01am, 27 December 2025.

During this time Mr Gourdeas is banned from providing, offering, advertising or otherwise promoting massage therapy services.

Ms Martin explained that she has received information from South Australian Police on this matter, and that investigation from the Office of the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner is ongoing.

As this matter is an active investigation the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
