Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Fubo Jiang

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC), Dr Lynne Coulson Barr OAM, has issued a further interim prohibition order against Mr Fubo Jiang, who provided massage therapy services in West Lakes.

Mr Jiang is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935* (CLCA).

An initial interim prohibition order against Mr Jiang was effective for a period of 12 weeks from 13 March 2025.

Subsequent consecutive prohibition orders against Mr Jiang were effective for 12 weeks; from 5 June 2025, 28 August 2025, 20 November 2025, 12 February 2026, and 8 May 2026.

This notice advises that a further interim prohibition order relating to the same matter will be effective for a period of 12 weeks, commencing 12.01am, 31 July 2026.

During this time Mr Jiang is banned from providing, offering, advertising or otherwise promoting massage therapy services.

Dr Coulson Barr explained that she has received information from South Australian Police on this matter, and that investigation from the Office of the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner is ongoing.

She believes that it is necessary to make this order to protect the health and safety of members of the public.

As this matter is an active investigation the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
