PUBLIC STATEMENT

I Steve Tully, Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) hereby publish a public statement pursuant to s.56C of the *Health and Community Services Complaints Act 2004 (the Act)* in relation to **COREY LYLE LUCAS**.

1. Between 3 August 2016 and 24 February 2017, I conducted an investigation into the provision of health services provided by Corey Lyle Lucas.
2. As a result of that investigation, I found that Corey Lyle Lucas was convicted of two counts of Aggravated Assault on 6 June 2016, a prescribed offence for the purpose of the Act.
3. The offences were committed while Corey Lyle Lucas was an employee at the Mitcham Residential Care Facility on 31 August 2015 and 9 September 2015.
4. Corey Lyle Lucas has consequently agreed to be subject to an order prohibiting him from providing the particular health services until further order as follows:
 - services related to the care, treatment or accommodation of persons who are aged or who have a physical disability or mental dysfunction including services provided in association with the use of premises for such care, treatment or accommodation;
 - ambulance services;
 - services to treat or prevent illness, injury, disease or disability; and
 - services provided by the following specified health professionals:
 - audiologist, audiometrist, dietitian, prosthetist, psychotherapist, therapeutic counsellor and social worker.
5. Breach of the Order is an offence against the Act, with a maximum penalty of imprisonment of 2 years, or a fine of \$10,000, or both.
