

SCHEDULE TO S.56C ORDER
PUBLIC STATEMENT
IN RELATION TO PHILIP MARK DALTON



I, Steve Tully, Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) hereby publish a public statement pursuant to s.56C of the *Health and Community Services Complaints Act 2004* (the Act).

Between 5 October 2014 and 9 January 2015 Philip Mark Dalton committed offences against the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act, 2004* to which he was sentenced in the Adelaide Magistrates Court on 15 April 2016.

Between 31 March 2015 and 16 November 2016 I conducted an investigation into the conduct of Philip Mark Dalton.

As a result of my investigation, I have found that Philip Mark Dalton has breached Clause 2(1) of the Code of Conduct for un-registered Health practitioners:

Pursuant to s 56(2)(b) of the Act, I have made the following orders in relation to Philip Mark Dalton providing health services:

1. *Mr Dalton is prohibited from providing or being engaged in a health service which involves the administration of Schedule 8 drugs or poisons;*
2. *Mr Dalton is prohibited from working in or applying to work in an ambulance or emergency service setting in South Australia;*
3. *Mr Dalton is prohibited from administering any Schedule 8 drugs or poisons to any person;*
4. *Mr Dalton is prohibited from consuming any Schedule 8 drugs or poisons unless those drugs or poisons are prescribed and administered to him by a registered medical practitioner and that if such prescriptions are made he will immediately notify the Commissioner prior to the administration of such drugs or poisons (except in an emergency or life threatening situation);*
5. *Mr Dalton is prohibited from working in a health service, or applying for employment in a health service, without first informing the Commissioner of any such proposed employment or application for employment;*
6. *Mr Dalton notifies any employer who employs him to provide a health service, of this order and the conditions upon him providing a health service;*
7. *In the event that Mr Dalton does not comply with the conditions of this order, this order will be immediately suspended and Mr Dalton will thereafter be prohibited from providing a health service in South Australia in any way.*
8. ***The above prohibitions remain in force until further order.***
