Carlie J. Angel and Brad T. Williams: Two Wolves – One Body

The South Australian Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) is aware an interim prohibition order by the Victorian Health Complaints Commissioner (HCC) Karen Cusack about South Australians Carlie J. Angel and Brad T. Williams, trading as *Two Wolves – One Body*.

The order bans them from advertising, offering or providing any general health service in Victoria, paid or otherwise, that involved, or are in any way related to, kambo.

Under legislative and code changes that came into effect in South Australia on Monday 18 January 2019, *Two Wolves – One Body* are also banned from offering services in South Australia.

This ban will be in place until the HCC investigation is completed.

The Commissioner is communicating with our Victorian colleagues about this matter.

Background

Kambo is the practice of using the poisonous skin secretion of a frog called *Phyllomedusa bicolor* (commonly: blue-and-yellow frog, bicoloured tree-frog, giant monkey frog, giant leaf frog, or waxy-monkey treefrog), which is found in the Amazon basin, for cleansing rituals.
