NAHLN Aboriginal Health Community Forum

The Office of the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) will host a stall at the Northern Adelaide Local Health Network (NALHN) Aboriginal Health Community Forum in Mawson Lakes.

The Forum is being held tomorrow (Wednesday, 25 September 2019) at Innovation House from 9am until 1pm.

SA Health and NALHN have organised the event for Aboriginal communities and Aboriginal health organisations to discuss the recent changes to the South Australian health system, and what this means for health care for Aboriginal South Australians.

HCSCC Associate Professor Grant Davies explained that the event was another excellent opportunity for Aboriginal consumers and carers to learn about their rights.

“This event will also provide an opportunity for service providers who work with the Aboriginal community to learn about their responsibilities,” Associate Professor Davies said.
