The Office of the Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (OHCSCC) will be participating at Celebrate on the Square on Friday.

The event is held at Victoria Square in Adelaide.

Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner Associate Professor Grant Davies explained that people living with a disability could still utilise OHCSCC services.

“While I am not able to deal with complaints about issues with individual National Disability Insurance Scheme plans, my office can still take complaints from people with a disability about general health or community services they may be receiving,” Associate Professor Davies explained.

“It’s very important therefore that people with a disability, their family, carers and service providers know that this avenue is available to them should they want to get some advice, or make a complaint.”

The public can visit the OHCSCC at stall number 4, which will be located on the western side of Victoria Square (tram tracks side), and take home important information about the services we provided and our free collateral.
