Public Statement: Varied Interim Prohibition Order – Ms Matilda Bawden

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) Associate Professor Grant Davies has varied an [Interim Prohibition Order](#) against Ms Matilda Bawden, a social worker.

On 13 October 2021 Ms Bawden was prohibited from:

- providing health services in respect of health education and/or the provision of information relating to COVID-19 vaccines.

Further information received about health services provided by Ms Bawden has given rise to a reasonable belief by the HCSCC she has further breached the [Code of Conduct for Certain Health Care Workers](#).

In the opinion of the HCSCC, further action is necessary to protect the health or safety of members of the public.

Accordingly, she is now also prohibited from:

- providing health services in respect of health education and/or the provision of information relating to any human physical health illness, symptom or condition.

The varied IPO will have effect for a period of 12 weeks, commencing from 13 October 2021.
