Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Yongan He

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner Associate Professor Grant Davies has issued an Interim Prohibition Order against Mr Yongan He, who offers massage services in the Hahndorf area.

The HCSCC is aware Mr He was convicted of indecent assault and that the assault occurred during a massage Mr He was conducting.

Mr He is now prohibited from providing massage therapy services.

The interim prohibition started yesterday (Thursday, 25 November 2021) and will be in place for 12 weeks while the HCSCC completes its investigation.

Associate Professor Davies said it was necessary to make this order to protect the health or safety of members of the South Australian public.

“This interim prohibition order will allow us to investigate this matter before deciding if we need to issue a prohibition order permanently,” he said.

“If there is any member of the public who has concerns, they can speak with us.”
