Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Jason Paul Hagon

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner Associate Professor Grant Davies has issued an [Interim Prohibition Order](#) against Mr Jason Paul Hagon who provides massage therapy services in Morphett Vale.

Mr Hagon is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935*.

The Interim Prohibition Order commenced yesterday, and Mr Hagon is temporarily banned from offering massage therapy services for 12 weeks while the HCSCC investigates.

Associate Professor Davies explained the HCSCC recently received information about Mr Hagon.

“Once I became aware of the allegations, I acted quickly to protect the health and safety of the South Australian public which is my paramount concern.”

As this matter is an active investigation and before the Courts, the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
