Public Statement: Prohibition Order – Mr Peter Karamalis

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner Associate Professor Grant Davies has issued a [Prohibition Order](#) against Mr Peter Karamalis who offers services in the north of Adelaide.

The decision to issue this order follows a comprehensive investigation into the services provided by Mr Karamalis.

Accordingly, he is prohibited from providing alternative and detox therapies (however described) to treat cancer and cancer related symptoms.

Associate Professor Davies said Mr Karamalis failed to provide evidence his detox therapies treat cancer and cancer related symptoms.

“This is in breach of clause 10 of the [Code of Conduct for Certain Health Care Workers](#),” he said.

“This section specifically refers to claims about curing or treating serious illnesses like cancer.

“The Code exists to address situations such as this.

“The health and safety of the South Australian public will always be my paramount consideration in these matters.

“If any member of the public has concerns, they should speak with the HCSCC.”

The investigation into Mr Karamalis also found him in breach of clauses three, seven and 11 of the Code.
