Public Statement: Interim Prohibition Order – Mr Mario De Ieso

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) Associate Professor Grant Davies has issued a [Prohibition Order](#) against Mr Mario De Ieso of Beverley.

In late August this year, the HCSCC issued an interim prohibition order against Mr De Ieso after receiving a complaint suggesting he had been providing dental services at his home.

Mr De Ieso was formerly registered as a dental practitioner but has not been registered to practise since May 2018.

Following the completion of a comprehensive investigation, Mr De Ieso has been prohibited from providing dental services of any kind on an ongoing basis.

Associate Professor Davies said the investigation found Mr De Ieso had breached several clauses of the Code of Conduct for Certain Health Care Workers.

“Mr De Ieso was providing dental services from his home despite not being registered as a dental practitioner,” he said.

“I believe Mr De Ieso’s provision of dental services poses an unacceptable risk to the health and safety of the public.

“This ongoing order will have effect until varied or revoked and means Mr De Ieso is no longer able to offer dental services of any kind.
