Public Statement: Prohibition Order – Mr Adrian Mangini

The Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC) Associate Professor Grant Davies has issued a [Prohibition Order](#) against Mr Adrian Mangini of Elizabeth North.

In March of this year, the HCSCC issued an interim prohibition order (IPO) against Mr Mangini after receiving a number of complaints.

Following an extensive investigation, the Prohibition Order permanently prevents him from providing health services (however prescribed) including neuro linguistic programming, counselling, mental therapeutic, hypnogram, yoga, reiki, massage and mediation services.

The order commenced at 11.59pm yesterday (Thursday 9 November 2023) and will remain in place indefinitely.

Associate Professor Davies said the investigation found Mr Mangini had breached several clauses of the [Code of Conduct for Certain Health Care Workers](#).

“I believe Mr Mangini’s services pose an unacceptable risk to the health and safety of members of the South Australian public,” Professor Davies said.

“This ongoing order will have effect until varied or revoked and means Mr Mangini is no longer able to provide any of the previously mentioned services.
