Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Peter Pabst

The Interim Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC), Ms Debbie Martin, has issued an interim prohibition order against Mr Peter Pabst, who provides massage therapy services in Newton.

My Pabst is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the *Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935* (SA).

The interim prohibition order will have effect for a period of 12 weeks commencing at 12.00am on 22 August 2025.

Mr Pabst is temporarily banned from providing, offering, advertising or otherwise promoting massage therapy services while the HCSCC investigates.

Ms Martin explained that the HCSCC recently received information about Mr Pabst.

As this matter is an active investigation the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
