Interim Prohibition Order: Mr Peter Pabst

The Interim Health and Community Services Complaints Commissioner (HCSCC), Ms Debbie Martin, has issued a further interim prohibition order against Mr Peter Pabst, who provides massage therapy services in Newton.

My Pabst is alleged to have committed prescribed offences against the Criminal Law Consolidation Act 1935 (SA).

An initial interim prohibition order against Mr Pabst was effective for a period of 12 weeks, from 12.00am on 22 August 2025.

This notice advises that a further interim prohibition order relating to the same matter will be effective for a period of 12 weeks, commencing 12.00am, 14 November 2025.

During this time Mr Pabst is banned from providing, offering, advertising or otherwise promoting massage therapy services.

Ms Martin explained that a further interim prohibition order against Mr Pabst is required while the HCSCC continues its investigation.

As this matter is an active investigation the HCSCC is unable to make further comment.
